### **Community Council Meeting**

## Wednesday, September 21, 2016

#### Agenda

- 1. Welcome and Community Council member introduction-Karen Burbidge. John Robison came and spoke about running for the school board.
- 2. Overview of Roles and Responsibilities of CC Members-Karen Burbidge. Duties include Developing a School Improvement Plan, plan for use of School Land Trust Funds, Advise and make recommendation to the school and district programs, Safe technology utilization, and other issues relating to the CJH students. Documents explaining the duties of CC members, chair responsibilities, and local training dates and locations were passed around the group.
- 3. Community Council School Bond Meeting 9/8/16 report- NA
- 4. Approval of minutes from July 15<sup>th</sup> meeting Voting for CC to fund ongoing ALEKS program.
- 5. Counselor Report- Mr. Griffiths Report on the Hope Squad and the 10 referrals that came last year. Students are selected by peer recommendations and can continue with the Hope Squad into High School. Discussion about the *afterschool.com* app that kids can download. It has access to their contacts lists and sends links to pornography websites. Explanation of the needs assessment survey for the school counseling program that will be coming via email for parents to access and fill out. CCR appointments are being scheduled for 7<sup>th</sup> graders, their parents, and counselors to discuss the student's academic needs and goals.
- Teacher Report- Janene Mann Introduced herself and the classes she teaches.
  Student Report Ally Seelos They are planning the Halloween Dance for October 28<sup>th</sup>. They would like to know the needs of the school and set up a fund raiser to help. A digital marquee was identified as a need. The cost and ways to partner with local businesses and the district were discussed.

Spencer Hansen presented a report on the state of the school. The recent reports and achievements of our CJH students from last year's test scores compared to the district scores.

A discussion of Teacher Grant applications will be tabled until next meeting to get specific costs of needed items and giving additional teachers a chance to apply.
