-He is planning on upgrading technology in classrooms and the library.

-Mr. Plant asked if we could use some of that money to run a Summer Charger Academy for those 9th graders who are credit deficient in core classes.

-We will be getting about \$135,000.00 for next year's spending plus our 10% carry over from this year.
